

Application to Install a Unit to Charge an Electric Vehicle at Ashton Lakes Community
Pursuant to Florida Statute 718.113(8)(a)-(h) and the ALC Rules and Regulations

Below is a checklist of items that must be complied with to install a charging unit for your electric or hybrid vehicle, whether it's a regular outlet or any other type of device. Your application will be granted when you have initialed compliance and signed and dated the form.

- ____ The owner has submitted detailed specifications for the installation.
- ____ The owner has engaged the services of a licensed and registered electrician.
- ____ The owner understands that installation and maintenance is entirely at the owner's expense.
- ____ The charging unit will be installed in the owner's garage or designated carport.
- ____ The installation will not damage community property.
- ____ The unit will be separately metered or sub-metered to the owner.
- ____ The owner has obtained hazard and liability insurance for the unit.
- ____ Within 14 days of receiving approval the owner will provide a certificate of insurance to the ALC and to the owner's association naming them as additional insureds on the owner's policy.
- ____ The owner will reimburse the ALC and the owner's association for any increased insurance premium attributable to the unit.
